Technology for Independence

WATAP provides resources and services to persons who face challenges related to disability or aging, to help in the selection and use of assistive technology to make tasks easier or possible in school, at work, at home, or in the community.

What is Assistive Technology or AT?

Assistive Technology or AT is any product or service that help with daily tasks and independent living.

AT includes any item, piece of equipment, or product that is used to maintain or improve functional abilities of persons with disability. A device can be low or high tech, off the shelf or specially designed.

D**evice Lending:** Borrow AT to try at home, school, or work to choose the best solution.

D**evice Demonstration:** Compare AT guided by expert staff to explore solutions for your particular needs.

F**inance AT:** Apply for affordable financing to purchase of AT devices and services, and get financial coaching and benefits planning through our partner, the **Northwest Access Fund**.

i**CanConnect WA:** Get devices for telecommunications plus individualized set-up and training for low-income persons with combined vision and hearing loss.

G**et Reused AT:** Find gently reused AT at reduced cost or for free from community reuse providers in the **Evergreen Reuse Coalition**. Exchange, sell, or buy gently used equipment online using the *AT Classifieds*.

W**ashington AgrAbility:** Receive information and services to support AT needs for farmers, agricultural workers, and their families.
